<u><b>Laser Treatment</b></u>	Laser treatable naevi (congenital and late onset) pre genetically determined skin tumours at all skin sites Abnormal hair growth or hair associated with scarring inflammatory disorders Inflammatory or infiltrated dermatoses Latrogenic or traumatic tattoos or tattoos associated with allergic reactions to tattoo ink Symptomatic viral warts ONLY associated with immunodeficiency states Rhinophyma Other conditions not routinely commissioned are listed
